

CHAPTER 19: ASSURED ACCESS ON TOWN ROADS

SECTION 19.01 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Chapter is to assure land owners access to any parcel of land or to any field having barriers to access from other portions of contiguous lands.

SECTION 19.02 ACCESS DRIVEWAYS

The Town Board must approve the location of any new access driveways to any parcel of land in order to establish the safest location and to assure proper drainage and placement of ditches on the "road right-of-way". The culvert type, size and driveway construction must follow Town Ordinance Chapter 13.03(D). The Town of Baraboo limits one (1) access driveway to any given parcel of land or to any field joining contiguous lands, unless the land owner provides a satisfactory reason for additional access, pursuant to Town Ordinance Chapter 34.

SECTION 19.03 COUNTY AND STATE HIGHWAY INTERSECTIONS

Any Town Road joining and or intersecting a county or state highway will not have any driveway installed on either side within two hundred fifty (250) feet of the centerline of the designated county or state highway. This Section assures the Town will have safe road conditions for vehicle operators at these intersections.

SECTION 19.04 MAILBOXES ON THE ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

Mail boxes will be allowed only on one (1) side of any given Town Road unless the Postal Service specifies otherwise on given sections of the road. This will assure visual safety to road vehicle operators as well as provide for safe and proper snow-removal.
