

CHAPTER 28: SEWER CONNECTION

SECTION 28.01 APPLICATION AND PURPOSE

This ordinance applies to new construction and to the replacement of existing septic systems with the intent that all buildings which may feasibly be connected to a public sewer are required to do so.

SECTION 28.02 REQUIRED CONNECTION TO PUBLIC SEWER

A. PROPERTY AFFECTED.

All houses, buildings, or properties used for human habitation, including occupancy, employment, recreation, business, or any other similar purpose, located within the Baraboo Sanitary District and abutting on any streets, alleys, or rights of way, in which a public sewer is located, or located anywhere where an extension of the public sewer is deemed feasible by the Town Board shall, at the owners' expense, connect directly with the proper public sewer.

1. Such connection shall be completed prior to occupancy.

SECTION 28.03 ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY

A. NOTICE

Any owner failing to comply with this Chapter shall be given a written notice to comply, by the Town.

B. FORFEITURE.

Upon the failure of an owner to complete connection within 10 days of such notice, the owner shall pay a forfeiture of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per day, plus the costs of collection.

1. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
2. Instead of assessing additional forfeitures, the Town may arrange for the connection of such system to the public sewer system, and the expense thereof shall be assessed as a special tax against the property.
